

Berkeley Castle Covid 19 - Tenant Update #44 - January 19, 2021

What happens if someone at Berkeley Castle tests positive:

We have been advised that an employee of one of our tenants went home sick on January 7th. They have since tested positive. They did not spend time outside their suite. Their employer has taken all the necessary precautions inside their office. All people with whom they had contact will have been traced and are also taking appropriate measures. At Berkeley Castle, all major touchpoints, and the washrooms will have been disinfected that evening as a matter of our regular “enhanced” cleaning. We wish them a safe and quick recovery.

This is an important reminder to stay at home unless absolutely necessary. Limit your movement within the complex when you come to work and go home immediately if you have any of the symptoms that can be associated with COVID-19.

CORRECTION: Above, I misquoted the email from the tenant with information regarding the employee who tested positive.

- The employee in question only began to feel ill three days after coming to work on Jan 7. There is no way of knowing if they were asymptomatic at that time.

Important addition:

We can not stress the importance of signing into the log book every time you come to the building (it has become apparent that there were people at the building on Jan 7 who did not sign in)
