What happens if someone at Berkeley Castle tests positive (again):

On Friday, we were advised of a second person at Berkeley Castle who has tested positive. This person is now in isolation. The two recent cases are completely unrelated. This person is a caregiver for an elderly member of their family and caught it from one of the other caregivers. Berkeley Castle management can not emphasize strongly enough the importance of staying at home if you can. The numbers in Toronto are still too large, and the risk contacting COVID increases when you travel outside your home. If you need to come to Berkeley Castle, (and at the risk of being repetitive) please adhere to the following:

- Wash your hands frequently and, whenever you enter the building.
- Stay away from others and limit your movement within the complex as much as possible.
- Wear your mask at all times in common areas.

Our enhanced cleaning protocols ensure that all common touch points, common areas, and public washrooms are cleaned as required.
