It's been a busy week for news:

Toronto's re-opening:

The [stay-at-home](#) order has been lifted, but we are still being urged to maintain caution. A CTV report says that nearly 7 of 10 downtown office workers would feel comfortable [returning](#) to their workplace. At Berkeley Castle, we think that's great news. We have continuously strived to keep the building as safe as we possibly can. However, Toronto is still in "[grey lockdown](#)", and Berkeley Castle's management strongly believes in caution and prevention. Don't let your guard down, if you plan on coming into work.

Vaccines coming to the country by the millions:

Canada is starting to receive vaccines in great numbers. Over [910,000](#) doses this week alone. If you have friends or family over 80, and they live outside the GTA, many have already received their first vaccine, and most should have an appointment. In the GTA, we have come to terms with the fact that we have a larger proportion of frontline workers who needed the vaccine first, and because of that, our 80-year olds are just starting to get appointments. If their family doctor hasn't already contacted them for an appointment, at the bottom of [this page](#) is a link for them to book/pre-register for an appointment. Health care workers, individuals living in shelters or experiencing homelessness, home care recipients and indigenous adults are also able to register at this time.
