### THANKS FOR ACCESS TO SOME OFFICES BY MANAGEMENT

We have completed our annual fire inspection, and all our systems (fire alarms, pull stations, smoke detectors, sprinklers, fire hoses, fire extinguishers) are working as designed, and have passed inspection. We are also moving forward on retrofitting all our older lighting to LED. We will be contacting tenants individually if they have any lights inside their suite that need updating.

### CHANGES IN THE 'HOOD WHILE YOU HAVE BEEN WORKING FROM HOME

The lot where the old Scobey's was, has been empty and in the hands of developers for at least seven years. Construction for the new condos started just before COVID. They have been moving quickly, but they are still a long way off from their originally projected May/2021 completion.
