550 health care workers got to see last night's Maple Leaf game in person (Woo Hoo):

After a most promising start to the series, last night was a disappointing evening for maple leaf fans. However, for those [health care workers](#) lucky enough to win a "lottery", it was an amazing evening, and was the first time since March 2020 that spectators have seen a game live in Toronto.

Stay at home order end tomorrow (Wednesday June 2) – here's what changes:

My major take-away is that not much changes, since we are still in shutdown with step one of the reopening plan only on June 15th. You are still advised to stay at home as much as you can, but it's no longer illegal to leave your home for anything non-essential. Those who live alone are now free to gather with one other household. If things improve before June 15, additional changes (like return school) may be announced.

Where are the new COVID cases coming from:

[Studies](#) are clearly showing that it is the unvaccinated who are showing up in hospitals. At a time when everyone in Ontario over 12 can now get a vaccine, it is terribly sad to hear about people in intensive care who could have already been vaccinated. People have their reasons for not getting their vaccine. I am not here to judge, but if you, or someone you know has for some reason not been able to get theirs yet, please reach out. Talk to your family Doctor, talk to friends who have been vaccinated or call a friend who can help. If you want to help someone who is [hesitant](#) these are good tips.

Yesterday was the second day in a row that Ontario's cases came in under 1000 people. We are moving closer to opening up the province. 65% of all Ontarians over 12 have now had at least one dose of their vaccine, and just over 6% have had their second. We need 1.5 million more second doses in people's arms by July 5th. If you got your first vaccine more than 28 days ago, you may already qualify for your second – use the link below. The sooner we reach these milestones, the sooner we can return to the life that was.
